

Hello SCSC Community,

On August, 18, 2022, Montgomery County Department of Public Health shared its recommendations for the upcoming school year, as it relates to COVID-19. We will continue to share information and make adjustments to ensure the safest possible school experience for the SCSC community.

- Anyone who wishes to wear a mask should continue to do so.
- CDC recommends vaccinations and boosters for all children and adults.
- While masking is optional, there will be conditions when masks will be required, particularly when a student returns to school after an isolation.

Testing Details:

- Students who are feeling ill should NOT come to school. They should remain at home. Contact your family physician for recommendations and pursue testing options.
- If a student becomes ill at school, SCSC is locating resources to be able to perform rapid testing when a student is not feeling well. Parents will be contacted by the nurse for consent to test.
- Individuals testing positive will be contacted by the nurse/administration and will be required to abide by the [Montgomery County Office of Public Health School COVID-19 Isolation & Quarantine Guidelines](#).
- Rapid Tests are now available for Free through the US government. Tests can be ordered using the following link. [COVIDtests.gov - Fjearee at-home COVID-19 tests](#). Once ordered, tests should be received in 7-12 business days.
- If your child should test positive for Covid-19, your child's teacher will contact you with information for activities that can be completed at home. Virtual teaching will not be an option during isolation or quarantine.

Facilities Cleaning, Sanitizing, Disinfecting, and Ventilation

- HVAC Units have been serviced and filters will continue to be replaced regularly.
- Healthy hygiene practices will be encouraged during the school day.
