



US Representative Brian Fitzpatrick Visits SCSC

U.S. Representative Brian Fitzpatrick toured SCSC to learn about our innovative and award winning school. He met with sixth graders to learn about their program which mirrors seasonal change in our natural world. Students participate in regular field studies, including tagging monarchs at Cape May, identifying migrating raptors at Hawk Mountain and building winter shelters at Norristown Farm Park. Enthusiastically, students shared their work on a self-selected, year-long independent I-SEARCH study, as well as how they practice resolving differences and conflicts with peace tables. Further down the hallways, Fitzpatrick met with third and fourth graders who demonstrated waxing and waning phases of the moon. He spoke with faculty members about SCSC's professional development process in which teachers identify goals and coach one another, building our capacity to meet student needs.
